

## Self Check AED Maintenance Log

## Overview

Regularly maintaining your AED is essential to ensure it's always ready for use in an emergency.

Here are the steps to maintaining your AED:

- Check your battery life and expiration dates
  - Most AEDs have a battery indicator showing the current charge level.
  - o Replace the battery immediately if it is low or approaching its expiration date.
- **Inspect the electrode pads** and other consumables (e.g., scissors, razors).
  - Check the expiration dates on these items.
  - o Replace items if they are expired.
  - o Ensure the electrode pads are not damaged or dried out.
